The Grace M. Brauninger Scholarship is open to women 25 years or older who are residents of Mercer County and attending a school in the state of New Jersey. They must be matriculated in a Baccalaureate or Associate Program with a minimum successful enrollment of one semester in that program; or a professional School of Nursing with a minimum of one year completed; or in a Graduate Program. They may be either a full or part time student at the institution. Financial aid form must be submitted along with the application.
